

Wedding Photography General Terms & Conditions

Photo Magentaplus, Pafos, Cyprus will be referred to as PM in the following text.

1. Summary of Service

To provide professional wedding photography services in Cyprus.

2. Booking and Payment Terms Making your booking with us

We will confirm if your date is still available and send our booking form and deposit form via e-mail. We suggest you book your wedding photography as soon as you have decided to avoid being disappointed and your date being taken.

We ask for a non-refundable deposit of €200.00 (payable by **Credit Card or Bank VISA Debit Card**) which is deducted from your final balance due here in Cyprus before your day. To be fair to all our bridal couples, we cannot hold the date until we receive your deposit. Your package is flexible and can always be changed at a later date.

Your deposit **secures your date in our diary and ensures we do not take another booking on your date. Your final balance is due in Cyprus before your wedding day.** *This can either be paid in Cash or by Credit or Bank Visa Debit card.*

Please note there is a 3% charge for paying your final balance by credit or bank debit card.

3. Date, Time and Venue Confirmation

If for any reason the date, time or venue is changed you must inform PM as soon as possible. If you arrive in Cyprus and PM has not been informed of changes, then PM will not be held responsible if we cannot provide services for the new date. If PM is unavailable for the new date, we will however endeavour to source a photographer on your behalf.

4. Coverage

PM will provide coverage for the date/s, locations as per your booking form. Additional travel or coverage hours may be added by agreement prior to the date or at a pre-wedding meeting.

Unless agreed upon in advance Jim McGrath of PM shall be the exclusive photographer retained for the event. PM may bring a second professional photographer, an assistant and/or videographer as discussed with the client.

PM is not responsible for compromised coverage due to causes beyond his control such as, the lateness of the start of the ceremony, schedule complications, wedding car/transport delays, persons taking photos/filming and getting in the way of the professionals, or restrictions at the venue/s. Every reasonable effort will be made to take requested pictures, but no specific pose or photograph can be guaranteed.

5. Photography Packages

If you wish to change your chosen package please let us know as soon as possible and we will do our best to accommodate you if the product is in stock or we will order for you if required.

Digital Storybook Albums

These packages take approximately 6 – 12 weeks for delivery dependent on any changes made. A PDF will be supplied with your album design for approval. Once approved this **cannot** be changed without incurring additional design, printing and binding costs. These packages must be paid in full BEFORE any design work commences.

6. CD/DVD

Upon receipt of a photo CD/DVD, the client accepts all responsibility for archiving and protecting the photographs. PM will archive image files for up to a maximum of 2 years following the event. PM is not responsible for the lifespan of any digital media provided or for any future changes in digital technology or media readers that might result in an inability to read discs provided. It is the client's responsibility to make sure that digital files are copied to new media as required.

7. Image Processing/Printing

Limited colour correction and/or retouching are included in the packages, but the client may request further changes for an additional charge. PM is not responsible for any prints that are not ordered directly from him. For clients with high-resolution image files on disc we recommend they order their prints through a reputable developing and processing lab.

8. Illness

In the unlikely event that PM (Jim McGrath) is injured or becomes too ill to photograph the event PM will make every effort to secure a replacement for you. Should you choose not to accept the replacement photographer offered, responsibility and liability is limited to the return of all payments received.
